#### **Contractor Rules**

- 1. Contractors and Subcontractors must supply the Association with a Certificate of Liability Insurance prior to start of work for at least \$500,000 in General Liability with the Ritz Condominium Association being the Certificate Holder.
- 2. Contractors must **SIGN IN** when entering the building and **SIGN OUT** when exiting the building.
- 3. Contractors are only permitted to be in the building between 8:00am and 4:00pm Monday through Friday. Contractors are not permitted to be in the building on Saturday, Sunday, or Holidays without Management approval.
- 4. Contractors must remove <u>ALL</u> construction debris and discarded materials from the premises. Such refuse is not to be deposited in the dumpsters or other receptacles which are provided for normal household use only.
- 5. All construction debris/refuse must be removed from the unit in construction trash bags.
- 6. The HVAC in the unit in which the work is being done must be covered at all times to prevent construction dust/debris from getting in the unit.
- 6. Carpet protection must be placed in front of the unit where the work is being done and all Common Area carpets must stay clean and vacuumed at all times. Contractors must keep all Common Areas including the Service Elevator continuously clean during the Construction process.
- 7. Ritz facilities may not be used for construction work or the storage of tools, materials, or refuse under any circumstance. Contractors may not use any Ritz owned construction or cleaning supplies of any kind.
- 8. The Ritz does not provide any equipment to aid in the moving of materials. Contractors must bring their own carts, hand trucks, and dollies.
- 9. If a building permit is required; such permit can be obtained from the City of Atlantic City Building Department. A copy must be submitted to the Condominium Office before work can begin.
- 10. All electrical or water shutoffs must be scheduled with the Condo Office AT LEAST 24 hours in advance.
- 11. Certain types of renovations including demolition and facility tie-ins are prohibited from Memorial Day to Labor Day (effective 2007). Please see Condo Office for determination before scheduling any work during that period.

By signing this document, the Contractor agrees to abide by the Contractor Rules stated above.

If these rules are not followed, the Contractor may be banned from doing work in the Ritz Condominium.
